PARTNERSHIP PROTOCOL BETWEEN KHMELNYTSKYI HUMANITARIAN PEDAGOGICAL ACADEMY (KGPA) AND INTERNATIONAL LABOUR ASSOCIATION (ILA)

This partnership protocol (hereafter referred to as "the Protocol") outlines the terms and conditions of a collaboration between Khmelnytskyi Humanitarian Pedagogical Academy (KGPA) and the International Labour Association (ILA). This partnership aims to facilitate exchanging knowledge and skills development between institutions by exchanging students and academic staff.

Objectives

- 1.1 The primary objective of this Protocol is to enhance the quality of education and research at both institutions by creating a platform for the exchange of knowledge, skills, and resources.
 - 1.2 The partnership will focus on the following areas of cooperation:
 - a. Exchange of students and academic staff
 - b. Collaboration on research projects and academic programs
 - c. Knowledge and best practices sharing on skills development

II. Exchange of Students and Academic Staff

- 2.1 KGPA and ILA will facilitate the exchange of students and academic staff to enable them to learn and work in an international environment, acquire new knowledge, and develop new skills.
- 2.2 KGPA and ILA will ensure the exchange program is fair and equitable, providing equal opportunities for all students and academic staff to participate.
- 2.3 KGPA and ILA will support the exchange program, including accommodation, travel, and visa arrangements.

III. Collaboration on Research Projects and Academic Programs

- 3.1 KGPA and ILA will collaborate on research projects and academic programs to enhance the quality of education and research at both institutions.
- 3.2 KGPA and ILA will jointly develop and deliver academic programs that reflect the current trends and demands of the labour market.
- 3.3 KGPA and ILA will encourage the exchange of research findings, publications, and other relevant materials to facilitate joint academic work.

IV. Knowledge and Best Practices Sharing on Skills Development

- 4.1 KGPA and ILA will share knowledge and best practices on skills development to enhance the quality of education and training at both institutions.
- 4.2 KGPA and ILA will organise joint seminars, workshops, and training programs to exchange knowledge and best practices on skills development.
- 4.3 KGPA and ILA will collaborate to develop and implement innovative training programs that reflect the current demands of the labour market.

V. Duration and Termination

- 5.1 This Protocol shall enter into force on the date of signature by both parties and remain in force for five years.
 - 5.2 This Protocol may be extended by mutual consent of the parties.
- 5.3 Either party may terminate this Protocol by providing written notice to the other party at least six months before the intended termination date.

VI. Governing Law and Dispute Resolution

- 6.1 This Protocol shall be governed by and construed by the laws of Ukraine.
- 6.2 Any dispute arising out of or in connection with this Protocol shall be settled amicably by the parties through consultations and negotiations.
- 6.3 If the parties cannot resolve the dispute through consultations and negotiations, the dispute shall be submitted to arbitration by the Arbitration Rules of the United Nations Commission on International Trade Law (UNCITRAL).
